

TICKET TERMS & CONDITIONS

In these Terms & Conditions, the "Organiser", "Us", "Our", or "We" means "Dutch Open Dance" (a trade name owned by Danscentrum De Vos, registered under Chamber of Commerce number 34024233) and "Event" shall mean the event "Dutch Open Dance Convention".

TICKETS

- Tickets are not refundable after purchase. Should a ticket be re-sold or transferred for profit or commercial gain by anyone other than the Organiser then it will become void and the holder may be refused entry or ejected from the venue.
- Tickets entitle the holder to attend the Event listed and allow entry for the day(s) stated.
- It is the responsibility of the ticket holder to check all tickets upon receipt, as mistakes cannot be rectified at a later date.

ADMISSION

- There is no admission to the event without a ticket.
- The Organiser reserve the right to refuse admission or to eject a ticket holder any person appearing to be intoxicated, under the influence of drugs, or otherwise behaving dangerously or inappropriately, for any other behaviour likely to cause damage, injury, nuisance and annoyance or for failure to comply with the reasonable request of the Organiser.
- No alcohol may be taken into the venue.

FILM & PHOTOGRAPHY

- As filming and photographing may be carried out at the venue from time to time by the Organiser, the ticket holder consents to being included in such films and photos and the use, reproduction, storage, distribution and broadcasting of these items (including any copies made) without payment.
- The use of cameras and recording equipment by the ticketholder for commercial use is prohibited.

CONTENT

- The Organiser reserves the right to alter or vary the content and timing of the event due to circumstances beyond their control without being obliged to refund money or exchange tickets.
- Please note that all participants taking part in the dance classes do so at their own risk. It is the individual participant's responsibility to warm-up correctly, wear appropriate footwear, dress suitably and inform the class teacher of any relevant health issues or injuries before the class commences. The management reserves the right to alter or vary the content, timing or teacher of any class due to circumstances beyond their control.
- Neither the Organiser nor the venue operator will be responsible for any loss, damage, death or injury howsoever caused unless the relevant party has



 breached its legal obligations; and such loss or damage is a direct and reasonably foreseeable result of the breach. For the avoidance of doubt, the Organiser will not be responsible for the actions of any third party, including but not limited to, the exhibitors.

RETAIL

• The sale of articles and/or services in the hallways or anywhere on the premises of the venue is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. The also applies to the distribution of leaflets. The Organisers reserve the right to confiscate any such articles for infringement of this condition.

LAW

- Not with standing these Terms and Conditions, Event tickets are issued subject also to the rules and regulations of the venue all of which will apply unless otherwise specified by the venue and, where applicable, the Organiser.
- The relevant Dutch law will apply to these Terms and Conditions and the relevant court of Amsterdam will have exclusive jurisdiction in relation to the Terms and Conditions.
